Appendix 1:

National Council for Palliative Care definitions
of Specialist Palliative Care services

1. Hospital / hospice specialist palliative care in-patient units

An in-patient is a person who is admitted and occupies a bed in the unit, not necessarily overnight. There are several types of in-patient admission:

- An ordinary in-patient is admitted with the intention of staying one or more nights in the unit
- A day case in-patient is admitted with a view to discharge the same day, that is, not staying overnight in the unit
- A regular in-patient is admitted as part of a planned series of short stays, usually of one day or one night each, for example for pain control adjustment or respite care. A series of day admissions differs from day care in that a person occupies a bed while in the unit
- An ordinary in-patient who does not actually occupy a bed for one night, for example an urgent admission who dies the same day, is still counted as an ordinary in-patient
- Someone who was a day case who for any reason does stay overnight in the unit becomes an ordinary in-patient, as does anyone who overstays the planned period of admission

Across the London Cancer Alliance (LCA), the only hospital trust that has an in-patient specialist palliative care unit is The Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust.

2. Hospital advisory service

Hospital advisory service teams work with other healthcare staff to provide specialist palliative care to people who have been admitted to hospital.

The range of services varies and may include:

- Specialist patient care requiring particular expertise, such as symptom control
- Advice, support and education for patients and carers
- Consultancy and education for other health professionals
- Liaison with specialist palliative care services outside the hospital

Hospital advisory 'teams' vary in composition from a single specialist nurse to a consultant-led multidisciplinary group and go under a variety of titles. The team may be based in the hospital but managed by an independent / voluntary hospice or other specialist unit; there are many different organisational arrangements.

A hospital advisory service involves one or more face-to-face contacts with a patient, by hospital advisory team members, normally taking place during one inpatient stay. Contact with a patient may or may not follow formal referral. Hospital advisory staff may also have a substantial workload not directly related to any individual patient.

3. Outpatients

An outpatient clinic is an administrative arrangement which allows people to see a doctor or other health care professional for consultation, investigation and minor treatment. Clinics do not necessarily have to be held at regular intervals or in the same location. A clinic usually lasts for one morning or afternoon.

For the purposes of this LCA Specialist Palliative Care audit, patients are considered outpatients, only if seen in a specific specialist palliative care clinic. Patients seen in other (non-specialist palliative care) outpatient clinics are to be considered as part of the hospital advisory service only.

4. Community Specialist Palliative Care services

There are many different organisational and funding arrangements for staff providing community specialist palliative care. Specialist palliative care staff may be based in hospices, hospitals or NHS community units, and work closely with general practitioners and primary health care teams. A series of home care visits involves one or more individual visits by home care staff. The visits making up a series may be by members of staff of different professional groups, for example nurses and social workers.

5. Day Care

A Day Care service is an arrangement whereby people attend for all or part of a day for purposes such as:

- Social interaction, mutual support and friendship
- Creative and therapeutic activities
- Clinical surveillance and routine medical treatment
- Physical care (such as bathing)
- Respite to home carers

Practice varies widely and units put differing emphasis on the social and medical aspects of Day Care.

Many different activities may take place within a Day Care session, and there may be contact with many different health care staff or volunteers.

People normally attend for the whole session, which may last a full day or a shorter period, rather than having individual appointments. A service where people attend for nursing care or therapy by appointment would be recorded as outpatient activity. However, an appointment within the Day Care session - for example, if they attend for a whole day during which they have an appointment with a hairdresser - should not be counted separately. Activities provided for in-patients only should not be counted as Day Care.

6. Hospice @ Home (H@H)

A community service which self-identifies as providing 'Hospice @ Home' delivers a mainly hands-on personal care and non-nursing support service, based in the patient's home, without Specialist Palliative Care Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) input. Hospice@Home patients may not be known to the specialist palliative care CNS team.

Care is usually delivered by trained health care assistants, with nursing support / advice. Hospice @ Home services are usually of a short-term 2 week maximum duration only, delivered within-hours or from 8am – 8pm approximately.

7. Rapid response services

Rapid response services deliver hands-on generalist nursing care out-of-hours. It is an add-on specialist-palliative-care-led, but not specialist-palliative-care-delivered, service and is distinct from a specialist palliative care CNS service that may be required out-of-hours or on an unplanned basis.

8. Planned night care

The planned night care service provides a Healthcare Assistant (HCA) overnight to those people in the last year of life that may have a high level of care needs and either they do not have a carer at home, or the carer needs a break. The HCA will attend the patient between 10pm and 8am; staying with the patient throughout the night should their support be required. The HCAs are supported if required by the Registered Nurses.

Planned Night Care services are often provided by Marie Curie Nurses and Healthcare Assistants.

9. Lymphoedema service

A growing number of LCA provider organisations provide lymphoedema services, particularly hospices, for primary and secondary lymphoedema. The audit is seeking to understand the range and capacity of these services.

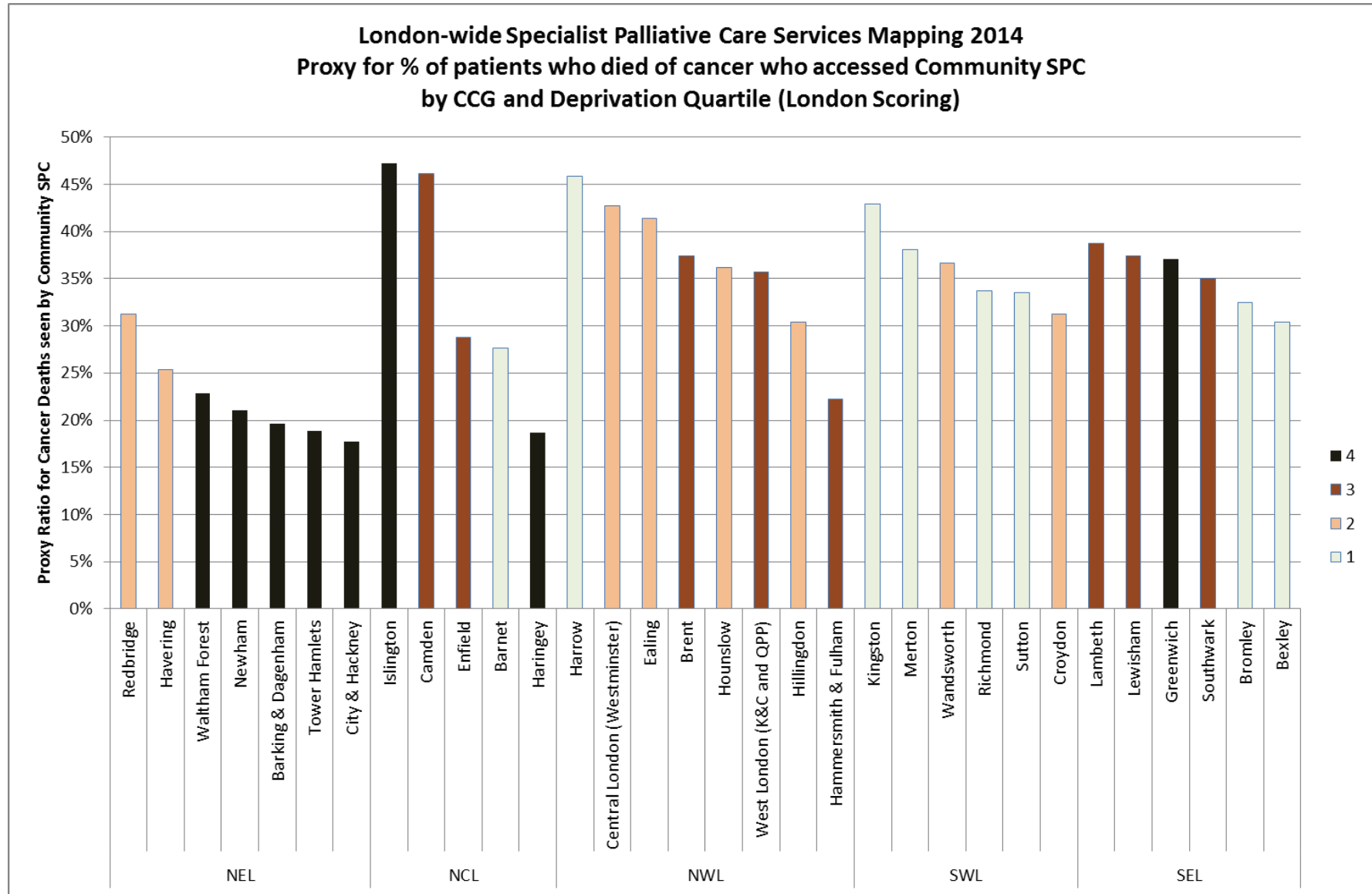
Proxy ratio for patients seen by community SPC and hospice in-patient SPC bed services to 'need'

In these slides the actual counts of deaths from cancer causes for 2012 by CCG are used as a proxy match for patients who might have needed SPC services in 2013/14, and these are compared with the aggregated CCG counts of patients seen by each service (with the % cancer patients for that provider applied). NB: outer London residents may be accessing services outside London (only London providers were included in the audit).

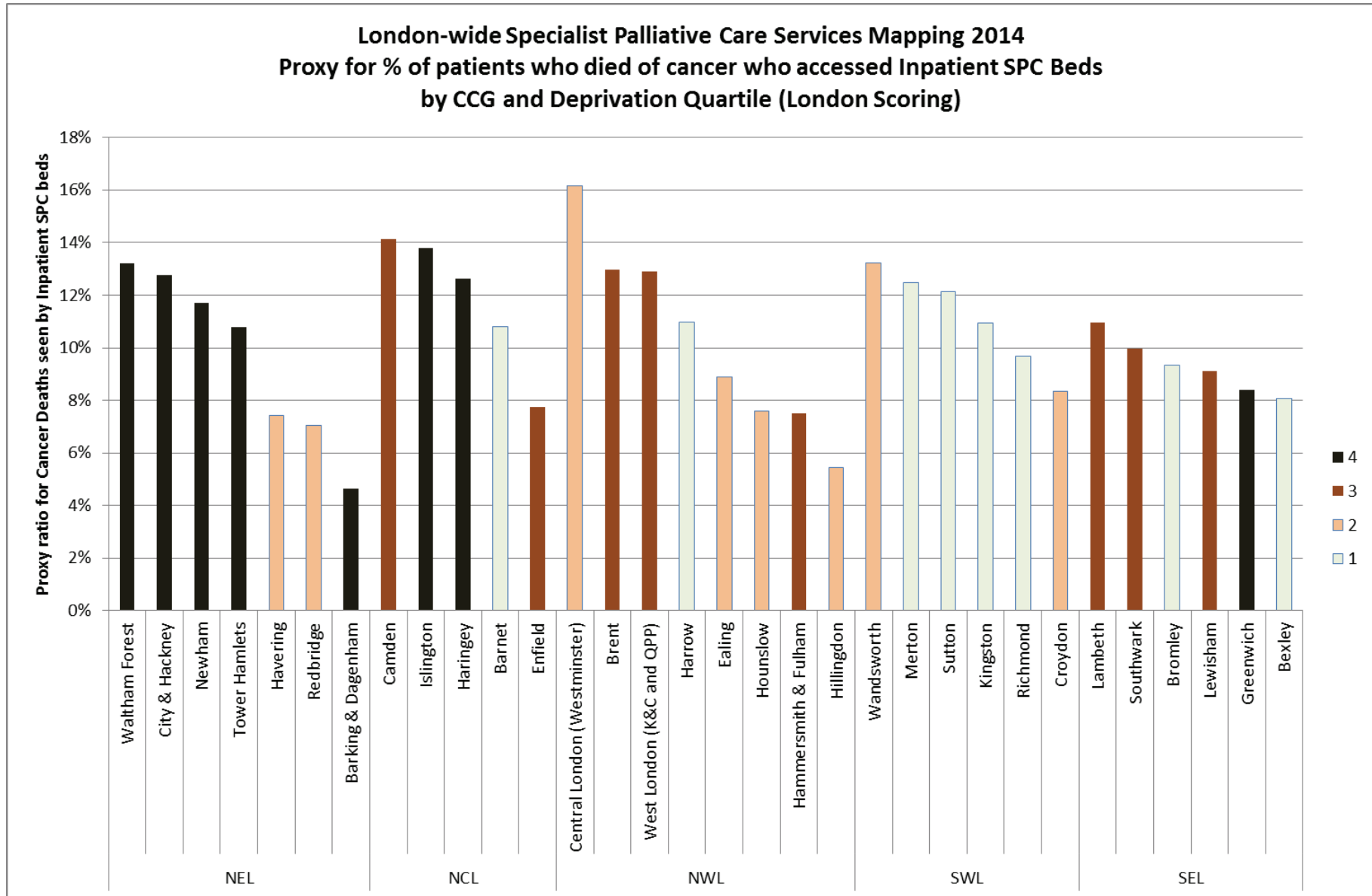
For example, Tower Hamlets deaths from cancer causes in 2012 was 1002. 137 Tower Hamlets individuals were seen by London-wide in-patient SPC services in 2013/14, of which 134 were at St Joseph's, who say that 78% of their in-patients were cancer patients. So we derive a figure of 108 cancer patients from Tower Hamlets seen in 2013/14 in in-patient SPC beds, giving a ratio of $108/1,002 = 10.8\%$. If there were 1,002 patients who died from cancer in 2013/14 and the number of cancer patients seen in a year in in-patient SPC beds is a proxy for patients who died from cancer and accessed in-patient SPC bed services, then we have a comparable ratio.

In reality, not all patients who access in-patient SPC bed services die during that year, and also more crucially, the outer London residents may be accessing non-London services which will make their ratio lower and therefore not comparable. Non-classified patients may also impact on the ratio for a CCG whose patients accessed the services of a provider with data issues.

London CCGs have been ranked into 4 quartiles based on the deprivation levels of ISOA's within the area. This deprivation scoring was taken from the 2011 London Cancer Alliance's audit exercise.



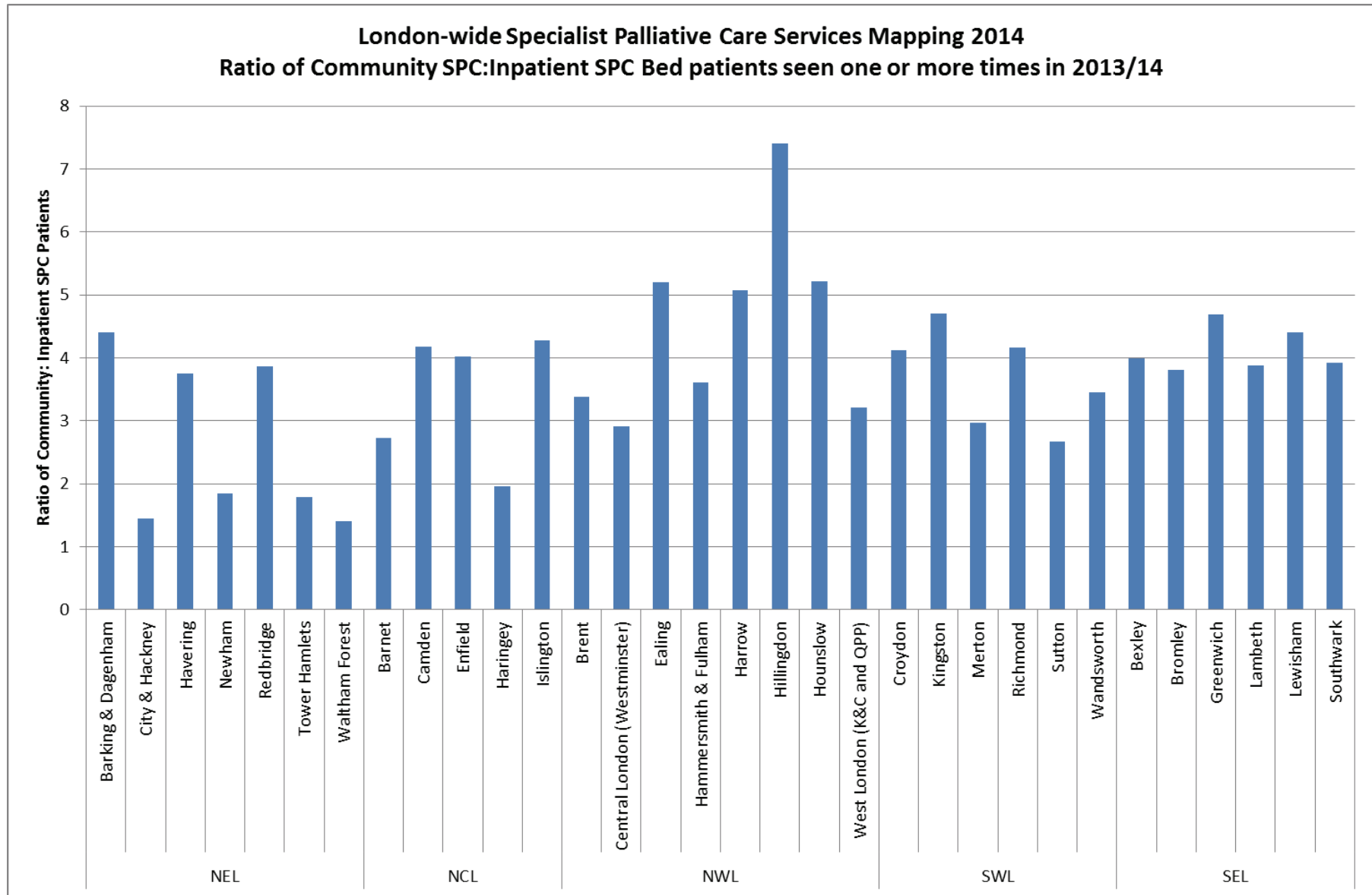

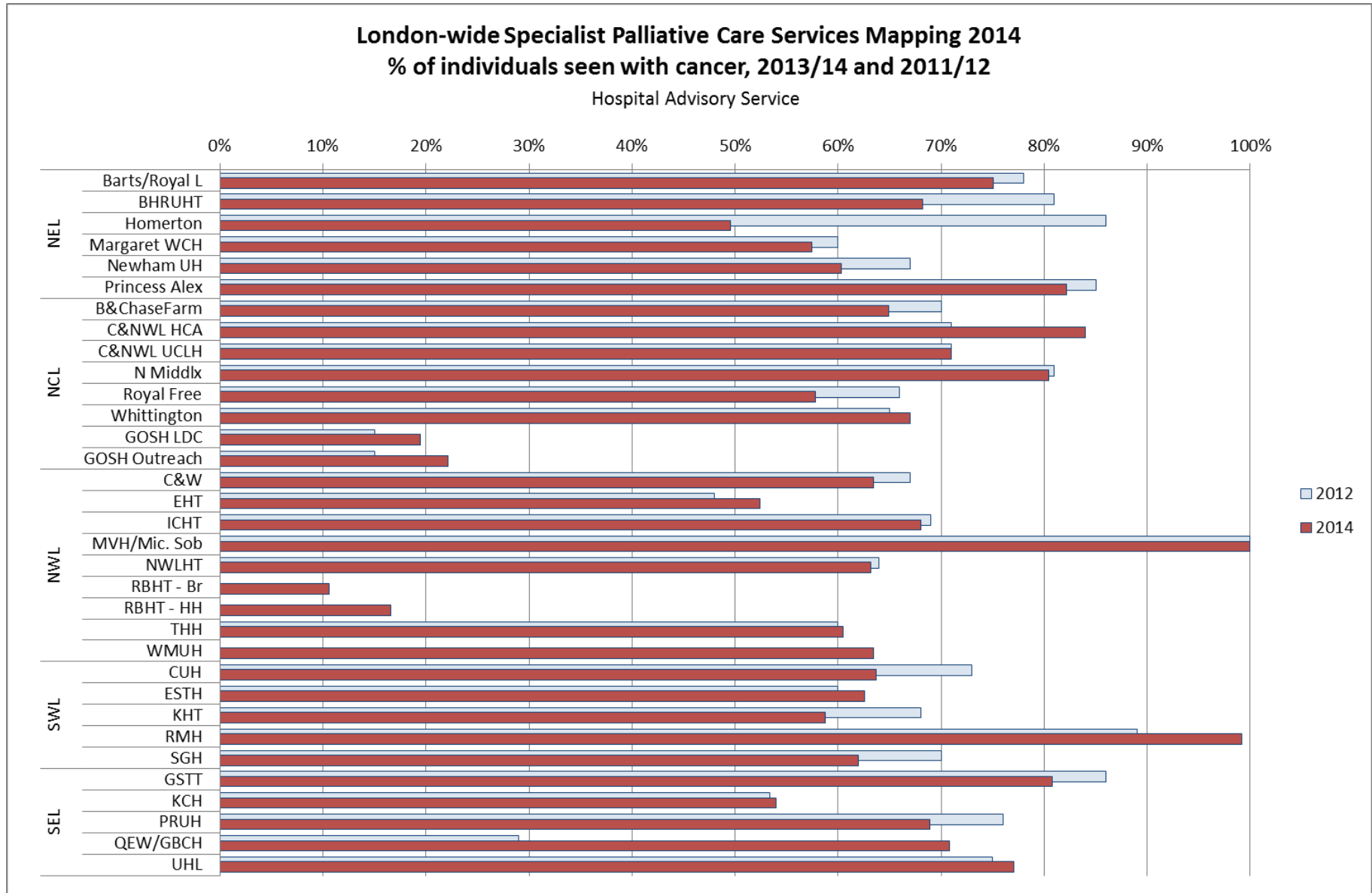

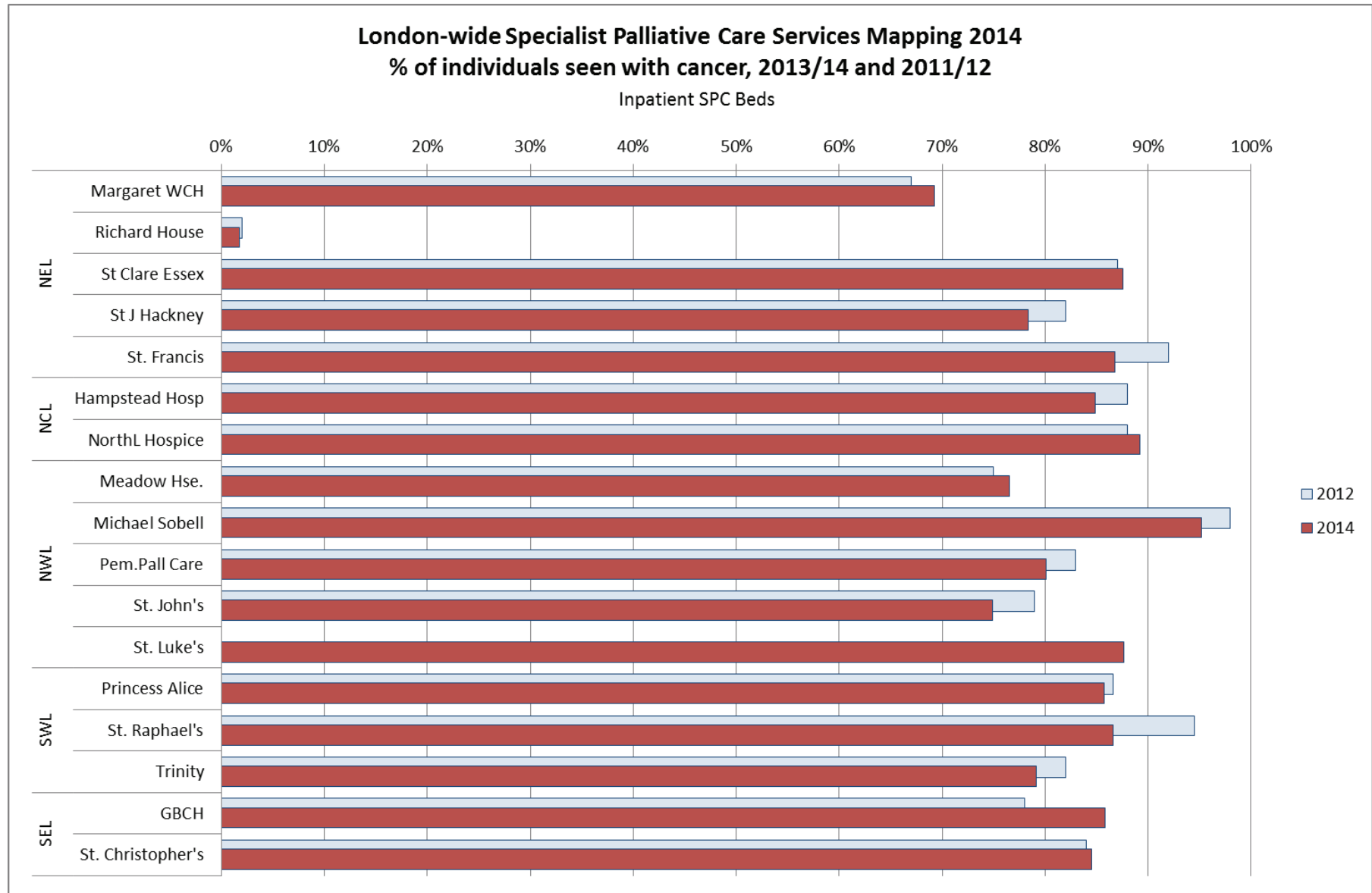
Ratio of community SPC to hospice in-patient SPC bed patients seen one or more times in 2013/14 by CCG

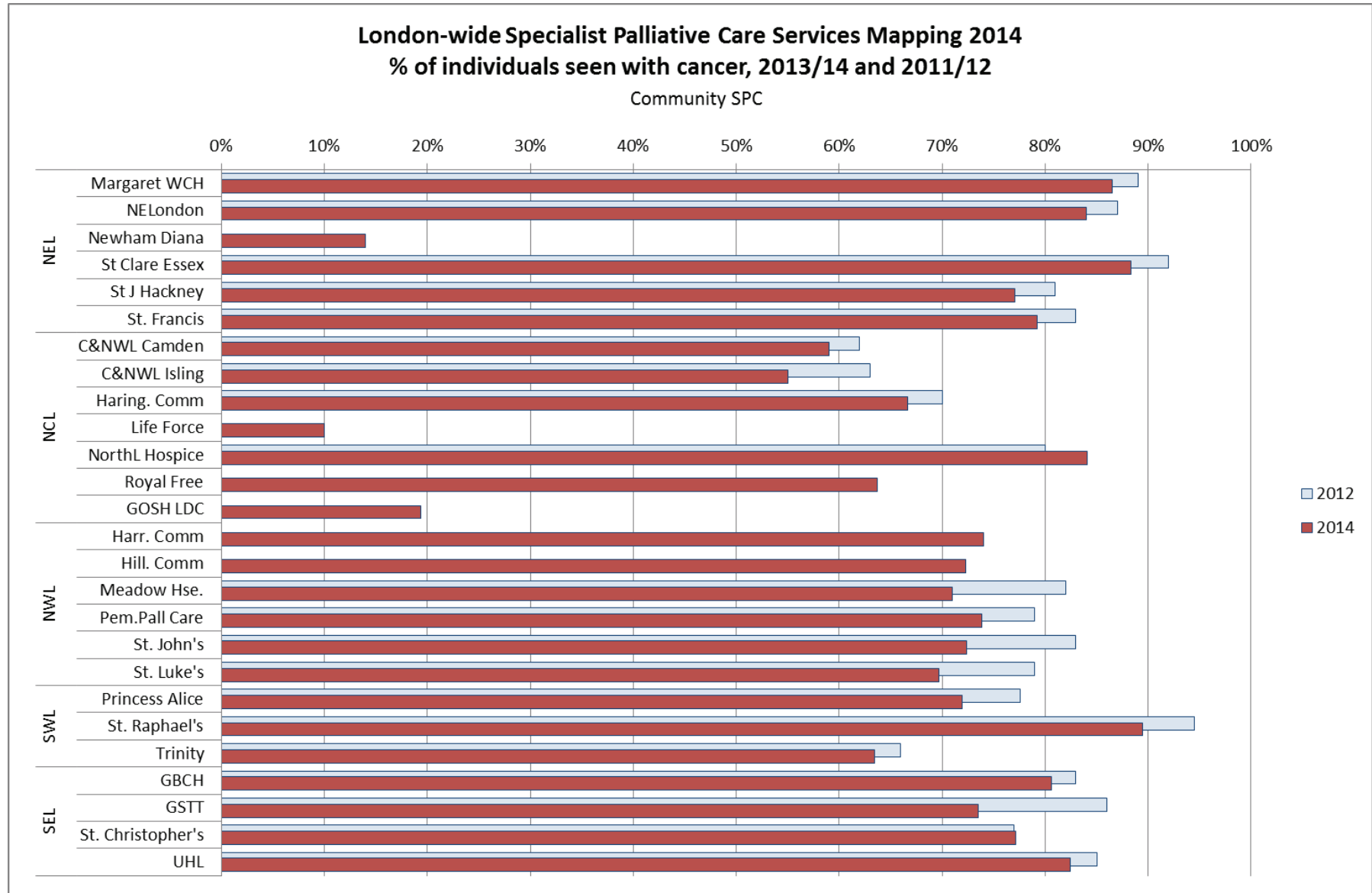

with cancer (2014 and 2012)

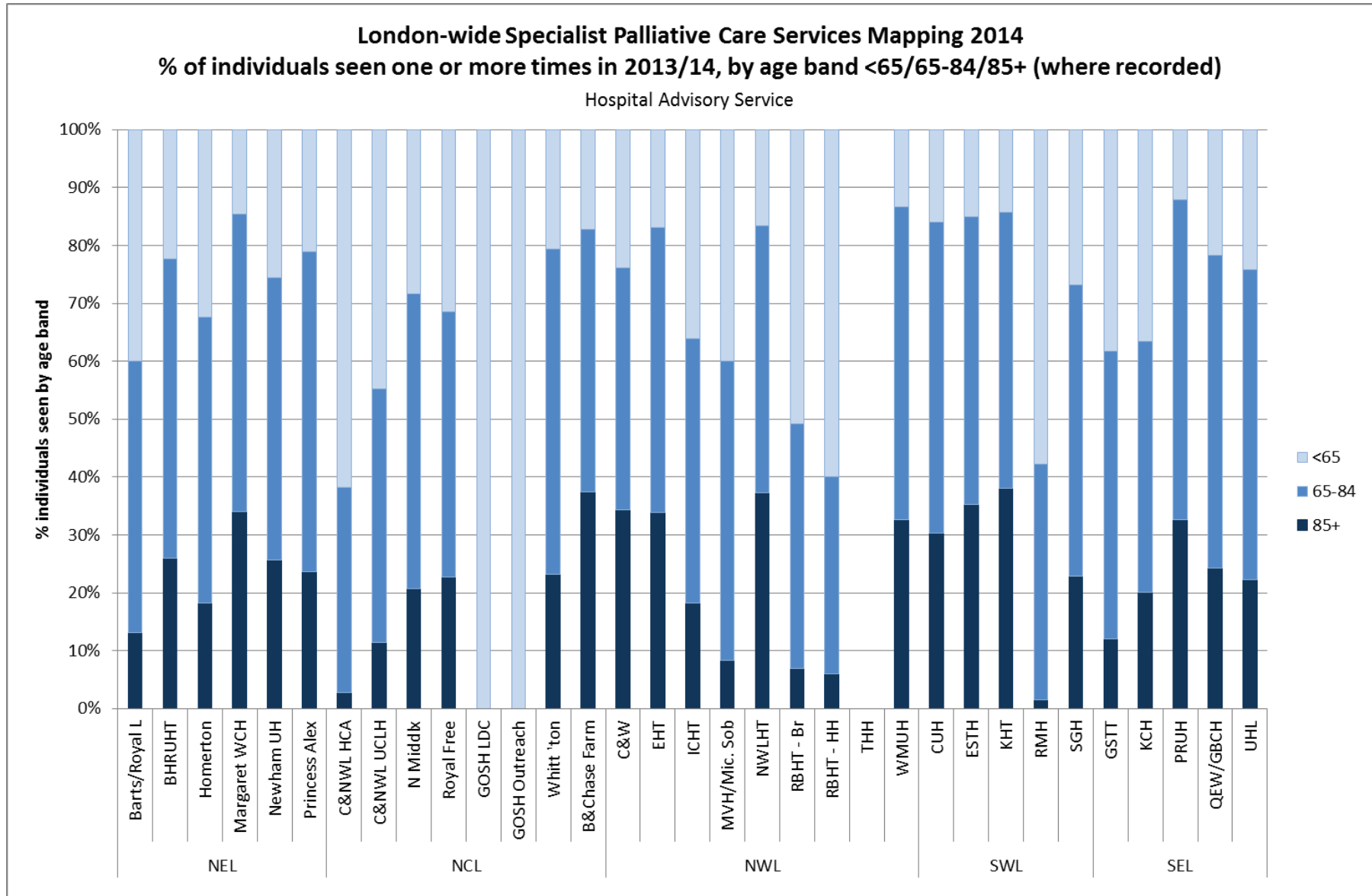


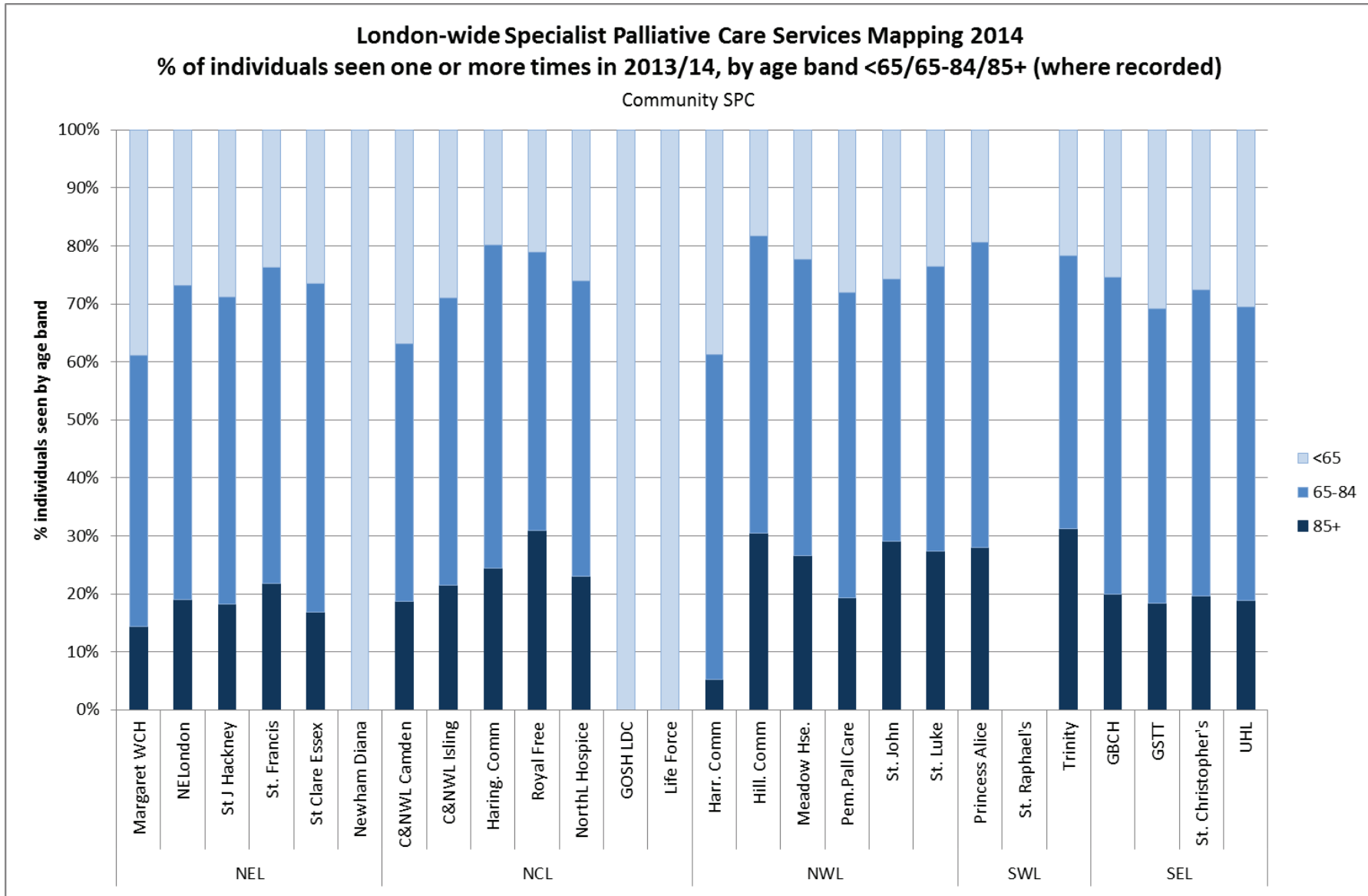


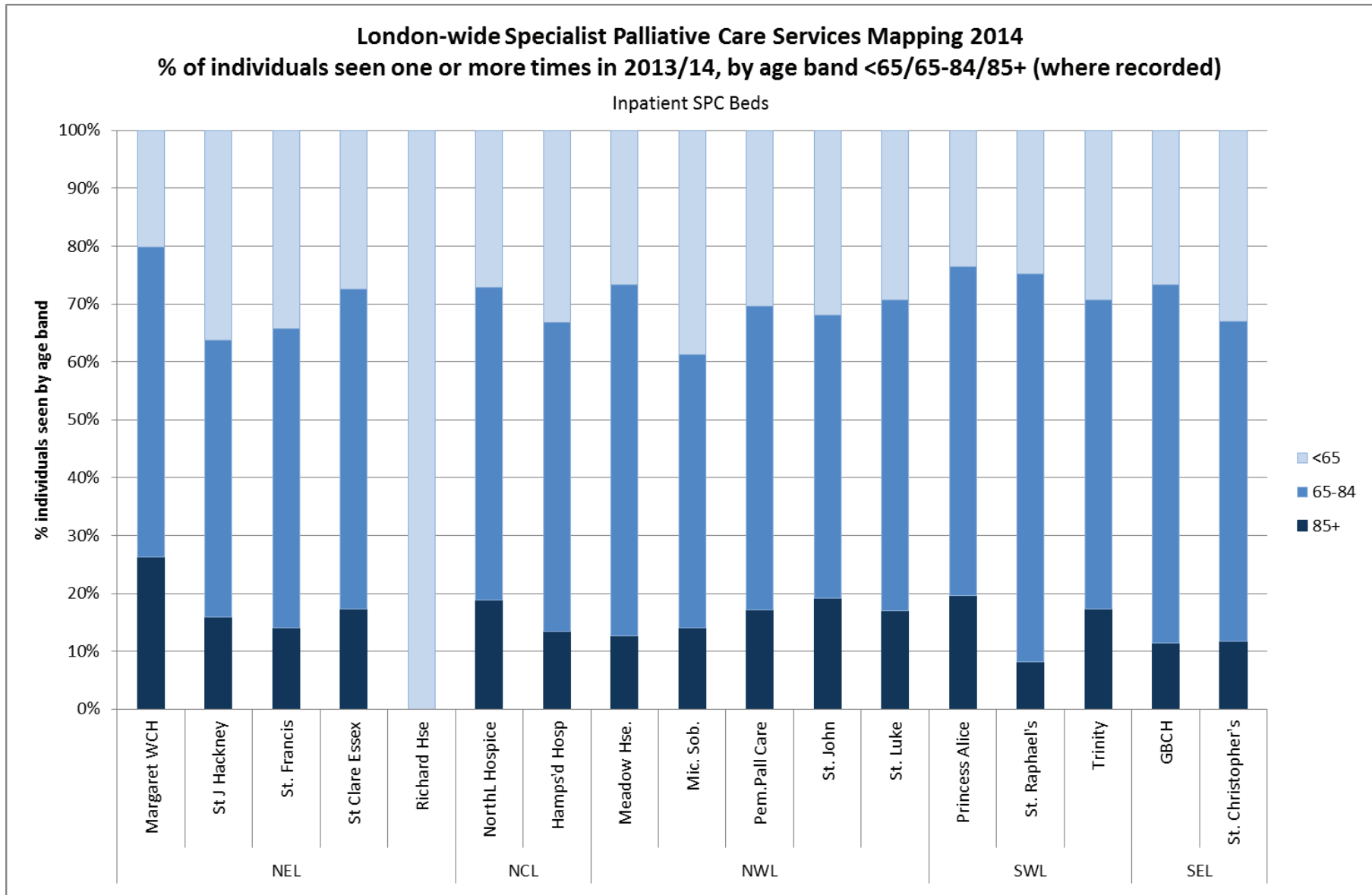
